

Admission to Primary & Nursery School

Application forms are now available from the school office for any child that is due to start pre-school or primary education.

Pre-School places are available for children who are in the target age group i.e. who were born on or between 2nd July 2011 and 1st July 2012.

All children born on or between 2nd July 2010 and 1st July 2011 must begin their primary education from September 2015 because by that date they will have reached COMPULSORY SCHOOL AGE.

All completed application forms must be returned to the school by 12 NOON ON WEDNESDAY 14th JANUARY 2015.
