If your child is starting preschool or primary school in September 2019, you can apply for their place online from Wednesday 2 January 2019 at 10.00am.

The closing date and time for pre-school and primary one applications will be 12.00



midnight on Thursday 31 January 2019.

Further information on the admissions procedure will be available in the coming weeks as it is made available to us.

Pre-school places are available for children who are in the target age group, i.e. who were born on or between 2nd July 2015 and 1st July 2016.

All children born on or between 2nd Jul y 2014 and 1st July 2015 must begin their primary education from September 2018 because by that date they will have reached COMPULSORY SCHOOL AGE.


