December Update

The Amazing Adventures of Super Stan”

As you are already aware this year we are having two performances of our Christmas Production “The Amazing Adventures of SuperStan” which will take place this Thursday (15th December) in the school. Tickets are still available for both performances (morning at 10:00am and evening at 7:00pm) from the school office although spaces are filling up quickly so please be advised to come and purchase early in order to avoid disappointment.

Thursday morning will see the stage set for our first performance at 10:00am. The performance will last approximately 2 1/2 hours (and will also include a 15 minute interval where all pupils will receive a free morning snack) therefore we should be cleared up for approximately 12:45pm. Following the morning performance school will finish for all pupils (Primary 1 to Primary 7) just before lunch time. If you are attending the morning performance you are free to take your child/children home with you afterwards and if this is not the case we would ask that you make arrangements for your child/children to be collected at school no later than 1:00pm.

Please note that Nursery pupils will receive lunch in school as normal and will finish at the usual time of 1:30pm.

In preparation for the evening performance which begins at 7:00pm, we would ask that all pupils are back in school at 6:00pm sharp in order to make preparations for the performance. If you are not attending the evening performance your child/children will be finished at approximately 9:45pm, therefore we would ask that you make arrangements to have them collected from school at this time.

Please note that during each performance there will be a short 15 minute interval where a tuck shop will be available and also Tea/Coffee with shortbread/mince pies will be available to purchase.
