## Help required!

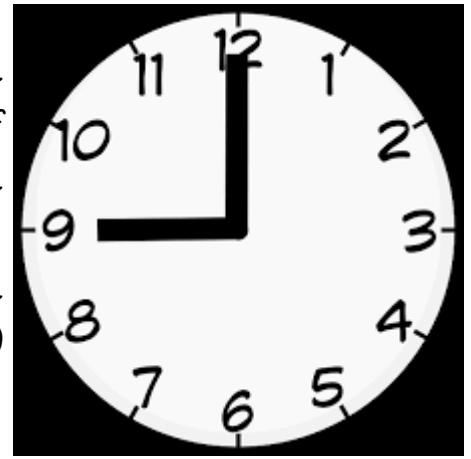
